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## **3. PROBLEMS IN USING ONLINE DATABASES**

### **ABSTRACT**

This chapter reports on the problems in using online databases among the postgraduate students at King Abdul Aziz University. Their problems included hard to access, different languages, unrelated to their field, insufficient numbers of computers, lack of assistance for library staff and insufficient instructions. They suggested that librarians must assist them in searching particularly with the vocabulary.

### **3.1 Introduction**
